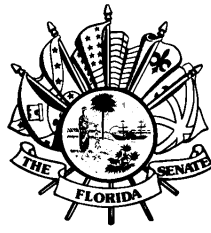

### BILLS ON THIRD READING

#### **CS/CS/CS/SB 1928 (3R) by the Committees on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations, Governmental Operations, Transportation and the Committee on Transportation (Baker)—**

**Transportation/M.P.O.'s**; requires commission to monitor transportation authorities & conduct periodic reviews of each authority; authorizes metropolitan planning orgs. & certain separate entities to establish per diem & travel reimbursement rates; defines term "metropolitan planning organization" for purposes of FRS Act; providing for creation of transportation concurrency backlog authorities; renames charter county transit system surtax, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 30, 2007*

*Compare to **CS/CS/HB 985 (HC)** in Messages*

---

#### **CS/CS/SB 1864 (3R) by the Committees on Community Affairs, Banking and Insurance, Senator Posey and others—**

**Hurricane Damage Mitigation**; redesignates Fla. Comprehensive Hurricane Damage Mitigation Program as "My Safe Florida Home Program"; revises criteria & requirements for hurricane mitigation inspections; requires DFS to transfer certain appropriated funds to Volunteer Florida Foundation, Inc., for certain purposes; requires DFS to develop no-interest loan program; provides requirements for buildings located in wind-borne debris region, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Read the second time and amended on April 30, 2007*

*Compare to **CS/HB 7057 (HC)** in the Committees on Banking and Insurance, and Community Affairs*

---

#### **CS/HB 1375 (3R) by the Economic Expansion & Infrastructure Council, Representative M. Davis and others—**

**Affordable Housing**; requires certain counties to adopt plan for ensuring workforce housing by specified date; authorizes local governments to elect not to apply transportation concurrency & impact fee requirements on accessory units on certain accessory dwelling units; requires local government's land development regulations to maintain density for certain types of parcels zoned for residential use, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/CS/SB 780 (SUB)** (Garcia), read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

#### **CS/CS/HB 197 (3R) by the Policy & Budget Council, the Environment & Natural Resources Council, Representative Machek and others—**

**Surface Water Protection Programs**; provides for regulation of peat mines in certain wetlands; provides applicability of variance provisions for activities in surface waters & wetlands in Northwest Fla. WMD; authorizes DEP & South Fla. WMD to adopt basin-specific criteria under Lake Okeechobee Watershed Phosphorus Control Program; provides for revision of water pollution operation permits; repeals provision re permitting of peat mining, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 594 (SUB)** (Saunders), read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/CS/HB 1381 (3R) by the Policy & Budget Council, the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council and Representative Richter—**

**Insurance;** authorizes certain agencies designated as branch office to file application for registration in lieu of licensure; provides exemption from required written examination to certain applicants for licensure as claims adjuster; authorizes certain licensed agents to be agent in charge of branch locations under certain circumstances; revises requirements for identification of insurers, agents, & insurance contracts, etc. Amends Ch. 626. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 2702 (SUB)** (Aronberg) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**HB 7187 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council and Representative Attkisson—**

**OGSR/Work Papers/DFS or OIR;** amends provision which provides exemption from public records requirements for specified examination & investigation reports under Florida Insurance Code & related work papers, information, & lists of insurers or regulated companies; defines "work papers" to narrow exemption for work papers & other information held by DFS or OIR pursuant to examination or investigation; removes scheduled repeal of exemption under OGSR Act, etc. Amends 624.319. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/SB 1850 (SUB)** (Saunders) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**HB 1549 (3R) by Representative Rivera—**

**Examination of Insurers;** extends interval at which insurers must be examined by OIR; deletes provisions allowing office to accept audit report from certified public accountant in lieu of conducting its own examination; revises guidelines for conducting such examinations. Amends 624.316. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **SB 2782 (SUB)** (Posey), read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

**HB 7201 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council and Representative Attkisson—**

**Public Records Exemptions/Economic Dev. Agencies;** provides exemption from public records requirements for info. re business activities & trade secrets held by economic development agency; provides specific exemption for federal employer ID numbers, unemployment compensation account numbers, & Fla. sales tax registration numbers held by said agency; provides for future legislative review & repeal under OGSR Act; provides statement of public necessity, etc. Amends 288.075; repeals 288.1067. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 1182 (SUB)** (Posey) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/SB 2484 (3R) by the Committee on Regulated Industries, Senator Haridopolos and others—**

**Lodging & Food Service Establishments;** revises membership provisions of DBPR's Hotels & Restaurants' Division advisory council; revises Hospitality Education Program; replaces director of education with division as administrator of program; revises provisions re administration of program; provides for use of administrative fines, etc. Amends 509.291, .302, .072, .261. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/SB 2498 (3R) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, Senator Garcia and others—**

**Insurance;** provides requirements for insurance coverage eligible for export for residential property risks; revises dates re exemption from emergency assessments for medical malpractice insurance premiums; provides that certain interest paid by insurer may not be included in rate base or used to justify rate or rate change; provides additional unfair claim settlement practices, etc. Amends Chs. 626, 627, 215.555. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

*Read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

**HB 409 (3R) by Representative L. Garcia and others—**

**Criminal Sentencing;** provides that adjudication of guilt or imposition of sentence may not be suspended, deferred, or withheld for attempted felony murder committed against law enforcement officer, correctional officer, state attorney, assistant state attorney, justice, or judge; provides for computing sentence points if primary offense is violation of specified provision, etc. Amends 775.0823, 921.0024, 947.146. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Substituted for **SB 566 (SUB)** (Rich) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/HB 517 (3R) by the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council and Representative Evers—**

**Financial Responsibility for Motor Vehicles;** provides that member of United States Armed Forces called to or on active duty outside state or United States is exempt from providing required proof of financial responsibility as owner, registrant, or operator of motor vehicle under specified conditions; provides for eligibility & limitations. Amends 324.021. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **SB 854 (SUB)** (Baker) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**HB 7197 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council and Representative Attkisson—**

**OCSR/Social Security & Financial Account Numbers;** amends provision which provides general exemption from inspection or copying of public records for social security numbers & bank account, debit, charge, & credit card numbers; clarifies penalty provisions; consolidates & revises current public records exemptions applicable to court files; revises date on which automatic redaction of social security numbers & financial account numbers by court clerks is required, etc. Amends Ch. 119, 215.322. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 1468 (SUB)** (Baker) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/SB 1736 (3R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations and Senator Fasano—**

**State Aid to Public Libraries;** revises grant eligibility criteria for multicounty libraries; revises determination for & amount of base grants; revises eligibility criteria, calculation, & determination for equalization grants; limits grants & grant amounts under specified conditions; removes requirement for issuance of warrants to political subdivisions eligible for certain funding; removes limit on amount of library cooperative grant. Amends Ch. 257. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/HB 1491 (3R) by the Economic Expansion & Infrastructure Council and Representative Attkisson—**

**Community Development Districts;** revises definitions re community development districts; specifies requirements for adoption of certain rules by Fla. Land & Water Adjudicatory Commission; revises provisions for determining certain voting units for landowners within district; requires districts to publish notice of qualifying periods for elections; revises timeframes & requirements for preparation of proposed district budgets, etc. Amends Ch. 190. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 2700 (SUB)** (Haridopolos) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/HB 1427 (3R) by the Environment & Natural Resources Council and Representative Zapata—**

**Agriculture/Agritourism;** authorizes DOACS to assist specified entities in agritourism promotion & marketing initiatives; specifies impact of agritourism participation on certain land classifications; requires local governments & agricultural representatives to meet to discuss agritourism; limits liability for injury to certain trespassers on agricultural property; increases criminal penalties for certain offenses re notices on posted land, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/SB 2754 (SUB)** (Haridopolos) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/CS/HB 1477 (3R) by the Policy & Budget Council, the Healthcare Council, Representative Ausley and others—**

**Forensic Mental Health;** creates Criminal Justice, Mental Health, & Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant Program within DCFS; authorizes counties to apply for planning grant or implementation or expansion grant; prohibits county from using grant funds to supplant existing funding; creates Criminal Justice, Mental Health, & Substance Abuse Technical Assistance Center; redefines term "qualified practitioner", etc. Amends 394.655, 947.005, 948.001. Effective Date: Contingent.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/SB 542 (SUB)** (Margolis) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**HB 7159 (3R) by the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council, Representative Reagan and others—**

**Pub. Rec./Lifeline Assistance Plan Participants;** creates exemption from public records requirements for personal identifying information of participant in telecommunications carrier's Lifeline Assistance Plan held by PSC; provides exception; provides penalty for intentional disclosure of confidential & exempt information by officer or employee of telecommunications carrier; provides for review & repeal; provides statement of public necessity. Creates 364.107. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 630 (SUB)** (Lawson) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/CS/SB 2136 (3R) by the Committees on Environmental Preservation and Conservation, Education Pre-K - 12, Senator Constantine and others—**

**Green Schools Pilot Project/Education;** establishes Green Schools Pilot Project to enable selected school districts to comply with certain building-certification standards; provides for application & selection process for participation in project; provides requirements for school districts to participate; provides for return of improperly expended funds & of specified funds if constructed or renovated school fails to achieve specified cert. standards, etc. Creates 1013.441. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

**HB 7193 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council and Representative Attkisson—**

**Pub. Rec./U.S. Census Bureau/Address Information;** creates exemption from public records requirements for specified U.S. Census Bureau information held by agency; provides exception to exemption; authorizes access to other related confidential or exempt information; provides for future review & repeal of exemption; provides statement of public necessity. Amends 119.071. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 632 (SUB)** (Lawson) and read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/SB 2078 (3R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations and Senator Bennett—**

**Agency Inspectors General;** requires agency inspectors general to comply with certain principles & standards; requires agencies under Governor to notify Chief Inspector General of inspector general appointments & terminations; prohibits agency staff from preventing or prohibiting inspector general or director of auditing from initiating, carrying out, or completing any audit or investigation, etc. Amends 20.055. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/HB 1489 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council, Representative Aubuchon and others—**

**Public Project Construction Bonds;** provides additional requirements for payment & performance bonds; prohibits conditioning certain bonds on performance of or payment for certain services; authorizes local governments to select construction-management or program-management entities to be responsible for certain construction project activities; requires firms awarded certain design-build contracts to establish guaranteed completion date, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/SB 2376 (SUB)** (Saunders), read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/SB 1140 (3R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Highway Safety/Driver Improvement;** authorizes HSMV Dept. to distribute safety awareness materials that do not include advertisements; provides that such materials include Official Florida Driver Handbooks; requires that other governmental entities including public schools, use books provided by department. Amends 322.025. Effective Date: 08/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007*

---

**CS/SB 1020 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Haridopolos and others—**

**Ad Valorem Taxation;** requires that property appraiser provide instructions to taxing authorities for computing rolled-back rate; provides that certain tax increment finance payments, taxes levied for payment of bonds, & voted tax levies are exempt from limitations on millage rates; amends specified provisions re taxpayer rights, approval of assessment rolls, disclosure of tax impact, & school district taxes, etc. Amends Chs. 192, 193, 194, 200, 218, 1011. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 19, 2007*

---

**CS/SJR 3034 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Atwater and others—**

**Ad Valorem Taxation/Tangible Personal Property;** constitutional amendment to authorize, by general law, exemption from ad valorem taxation of up to \$25,000 of assessed value on each tangible personal property tax return & to schedule amendment to take effect on January 1, 2009; to provide that assessed value of new homestead must equal or exceed assessed value of previous homestead, etc. Amends ss. 3, 4, 6, Art. VII; creates new section, Art. XII.

*Read the second time on April 19, 2007*

---

**CS/SB 1022 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Haridopolos and others—**

**Affordable Housing;** requires appraisers to use income approach when assessing affordable housing property that has low-income tax credit; provides for just valuation of affordable housing property; requires property appraisers to use income approach when assessing such property; specifies kinds of property subject to assessment. Amends 193.017; creates 193.018. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 19, 2007*

---

**CS/CS/SB 560 (3R) by the Committees on Finance and Tax, Community Affairs, Senator Atwater and others—**

**Local Governments;** requires that value of expected future tax benefits for homestead property be compensated for in eminent domain taking; requires that county, municipality, or special district hold certain public hearings before adopting ordinance or resolution increasing impact fee; specified data to be used for tabulating property value & taxation including information concerning ad valorem taxes & millage rates, etc. Amends Ch. 73, 163.31801, 193.011, 195.052, 200.069. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 19, 2007*

---

**CS/CS/SB 1982 (3R) by the Committees on General Government Appropriations, Environmental Preservation and Conservation and the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation (Saunders)—**

**Recreational Licenses & Permits/FWC;** authorizes FWC, tax collectors, & certain subagents to request & collect donations when selling recreational license or permit; revises exemption under which resident need not possess license in order to fish in salt water from land or from structure fixed to land; requires commission to provide to Governor & Legislature report on activities funded from sale of snook permits; corrects reference to spiny lobster, etc. Amends Ch. 372. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 26, 2007*

## **SPECIAL ORDER CALENDAR FOR WEDNESDAY, MAY 2, 2007**

### **CS/CS/SB 2250 (SO) by the Committees on Governmental Operations, Military Affairs and Domestic Security, Senator Deutch and others—**

**Iran/Divestment of Public Funds;** requires SBA to identify all companies doing certain types of business in or with Iran in which public moneys are invested; requires SBA to create & maintain Scrutinized Company List that names all such companies; requires board to divest company of all publicly traded securities of said company under certain conditions; provides exceptions to divestment requirement; exempts SBA from certain statutory or common law obligations, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Operations and the Committee on General Government Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*

---

### **CS/SB 96 (SO) by the Committee on Commerce, Senator Saunders and others—**

**Entertainment Industry/Economic Development;** provides for inclusion of tax credits granted to certain productions under specified provision, in exemptions to sales tax; revises entertainment industry financial incentive program to allow credit against corporate income taxes & sales & use taxes to qualified entertainment entities rather than reimbursements from appropriations; requires inclusion of marketing materials promoting this state as condition of receiving tax credit, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce and the Committee on Finance and Tax, reports the committee substitute favorably, with one amendment and withdrawn from the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

*Similar to **CS/CS/HB 1325 (HC)** in Messages*

---

### **CS/SB 434 (SO) by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs and Senator Jones—**

**Caregivers for Adults;** authorizes DOEA to create pilot program in certain counties to train economically disadvantaged workers who are specified age or older to act as companions & provide certain services to frail & vulnerable adults in community; specifies additional purposes of pilot program; requires evaluation & report to Legislature. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and withdrawn from the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations*

*Similar to **CS/HB 397 (HC)** in Messages*

---

## **CS/SB 606 (SO) by the Committee on Finance and Tax and Senator Geller—**

**S. Fla. Reg. Transportation Auth.;** revises provisions re powers & duties of South Florida Regional Transportation Authority; authorizes authority to issue, reissue, or redeem certain bonds; requires authority to sell such bonds at public sale; authorizes authority to enter into trust indentures or other agreements & to assign & pledge revenues, fees, rentals, tolls, & other charges, etc. Amends 343.54,.55,.58. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Reported favorably by the Committees on Transportation and Community Affairs and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Finance and Tax, and withdrawn from the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

---

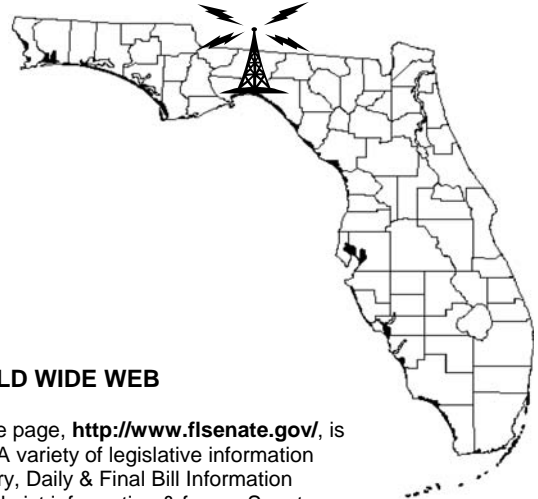
