Public Records Exemptions/Economic Dev. Lodging & Food Service Establishments; revises membership provisions of DBPR's Hotels & Restaurants' Division advisory council; revises Hospitality Education Program; replaces director of education with division as administrator of program; revises provisions re administration of program; provides for use of administrative fines, etc. Amends 509.291,.302,.072,.261. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

CS/SB 2498 (3R) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, Senator Garcia and others—

Insurance; provides requirements for insurance coverage eligible for export for residential property risks; revises dates re exemption from emergency assessments for medical malpractice insurance premiums; provides that certain interest paid by insurer may not be included in rate base or used to justify rate or rate change; provides additional unfair claim settlement practices, etc. Amends Chs. 626, 627, 215.555. Amends 324.021. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

HB 7197 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council and Representative Attkisson—

OGSR/Social Security & Financial Account Numbers; amends provision which provides general exemption from inspection or copying of public records for social security numbers & bank account, debit, charge, & credit card numbers; clarifies penalty provisions; consolidates & revises current public records exemptions applicable to court files; revises date on which automatic redaction of social security numbers & financial account numbers by court clerks is required, etc. Amends Ch. 119, 215.322. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

CS/SB 1736 (3R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations and Senator Fasano—

State Aid to Public Libraries; revises grant eligibility criteria for multicounty libraries; revises determination for & amount of base grants; revises eligibility criteria, calculation, & determination for equalization grants; limits grants & grant amounts under specified conditions; removes requirement for issuance of warrants to political subdivisions eligible for certain funding; removes limit on amount of library cooperative grant. Amends 119.071. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Substituted for **CS/SB 632 (SUB)** (Lawson) and read the second time on May 1, 2007

CS/SB 2078 (3R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations and Senator Bennett—

Agency Inspectors General; requires agency inspectors general to comply with certain principles & standards; requires agencies under Governor to notify Chief Inspector General of inspector general appointments & terminations; prohibits agency staff from preventing or prohibiting inspector general or director of auditing from initiating, carrying out, or completing any audit or investigation, etc. Amends 20.055. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time on May 1, 2007

CS/HB 1489 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council, Representative Aubuchon and others—

Public Project Construction Bonds; provides additional requirements for payment & performance bonds; prohibits conditioning certain bonds on performance of or payment for certain services; authorizes local governments to select construction-management or program-management entities to be responsible for certain construction project activities; requires firms awarded certain design-build contracts to establish guaranteed completion date, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Substituted for **CS/CS/SB 2376 (SUB)** (Saunders), read the second time and amended on May 1, 2007

CS/SB 1140 (3R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—

Highway Safety/Driver Improvement; authorizes HSMV Dept. to distribute safety awareness materials that do not include advertisements; provides that such materials include Official Florida Driver Handbooks; requires that other governmental entities including public schools, use books provided by department. Amends 322.025. Effective Date: 08/01/2007.

CS/SB 1020 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Haridopolos and others—

Ad Valorem Taxation; requires that property appraiser provide instructions to taxing authorities for computing rolled-back rate; provides that certain tax increment finance payments, taxes levied for payment of bonds, & voted tax levies are exempt from limitations on millage rates; amends specified provisions re taxpayer rights, approval of assessment rolls, disclosure of tax impact, & school district taxes, etc. Amends Chs. 192, 193, 194, 200, 218, 1011. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time and amended on April 19, 2007

CS/SJR 3034 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Atwater and others—

Ad Valorem Taxation/Tangible Personal Property;

constitutional amendment to authorize, by general law, exemption from ad valorem taxation of up to \$25,000 of assessed value on each tangible personal property tax return & to schedule amendment to take effect on January 1, 2009; to provide that assessed value of new homestead must equal or exceed assessed value of previous homestead, etc. Amends ss. 3, 4, 6, Art. VII; creates new section, Art. XII.

Read the second time on April 19, 2007

CS/SB 1022 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Haridopolos and others—

Affordable Housing; requires appraisers to use income approach when assessing affordable housing property that has low-income tax credit; provides for just valuation of affordable housing property; requires property appraisers to use income approach when assessing such property; specifies kinds of property subject to assessment. Amends 193.017; creates 193.018. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time on April 19, 2007

CS/CS/SB 560 (3R) by the Committees on Finance and Tax, Community Affairs, Senator Atwater and others—

Local Governments; requires that value of expected future tax benefits for homestead property be compensated for in eminent domain taking; requires that county, municipality, or special district hold certain public hearings before adopting ordinance or resolution increasing impact fee; specified data to be used for tabulating property value & taxation including information concerning ad valorem taxes & millage rates, etc. Amends Ch. 73, 163.31801, 193.011, 195.052, 200.069. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

CS/CS/SB 1982 (3R) by the Committees on General Government Appropriations, Environmental Preservation and Conservation and the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation (Saunders)—

Recreational Licenses & Permits/FWC; authorizes FWC, tax collectors, & certain subagents to request & collect donations when selling recreational license or permit; revises exemption under which resident need not possess license in order to fish in salt water from land or from structure fixed to land; requires commission to provide to Governor & Legislature report on activities funded from sale of snook permits; corrects reference to spiny lobster, etc. Amends Ch. 372. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

Entertainment Industry/Economic Development; provides for inclusion of tax credits granted to certain productions under specified provision, in exemptions to sales tax; revises entertainment industry financial incentive program to allow credit against corporate income taxes & sales & use taxes to qualified entertainment entities rather than reimbursements from appropriations; requires inclusion of marketing materials promoting this state as condition of receiving tax credit, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce and the Committee on Finance and Tax, reports the committee substitute favorably, with one amendment and withdrawn from the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations

Similar to CS/CS/HB 1325 (HC) in Messages

CS/SB 434 (SO) by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs and Senator Jones—

Caregivers for Adults; authorizes DOEA to create pilot program in certain counties to train economically disadvantaged workers who are specified age or older to act as companions & provide certain services to frail & vulnerable adults in community; specifies additional purposes of pilot program; requires evaluation & report to Legislature. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and withdrawn from the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations

Similar to CS/HB 397 (HC) in Messages

CS/SB 606 (SO) by the Committee on Finance and Tax and Senator Geller—

S. Fla. Reg. Transportation Auth.; revises provisions re powers & duties of South Florida Regional Transportation Authority; authorizes authority to issue, reissue, or redeem certain bonds; requires authority to sell such bonds at public sale; authorizes authority to enter into trust indentures or other agreements & to assign & pledge revenues, fees, rentals, tolls, & other charges, etc. Amends 343.54,.55,.58. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committees on Transportation and Community Affairs and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Finance and Tax, and withdrawn from the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations

CS/SB 2084 (SO) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Bennett—

Financial Services; sets forth requirements & prohibitions for selling guaranteed asset protection products; includes debt-cancellation products under casualty insurance; revises limitations on amount of authorized insurance for debtors; provides that deposit account by husband & wife is tenancy by entirety; requires state bank or trust company to file written notice before increasing its capital stock, etc. Amends Chs. 520, 624, 627, 655, 658. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, and the Committee on Commerce reports the committee substitute favorably and withdrawn from the Committees on Finance and Tax, and General Government Appropriations

Similar to HB 7087 (HC) in Messages

CS/CS/SB 1822 (SO) by the Committees on Community Affairs, Banking and Insurance, Senator Garcia and others—

Carbon Monoxide Detectors; requires that certain public lodging establishments be equipped with carbon monoxide sensor devices; cites act as "Janelle's Law"; requires buildings constructed on or after specified date which have fossil-fuel-burning appliance, fireplace, or attached garage to have carbon monoxide alarms installed; requires Florida Building Commission to adopt rules; provides definitions. Amends 509.211; creates 553.885. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, and withdrawn from the Committee on Regulated Industries and reported favorably as acommittee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs and withdrawn from the Committee on General Government Appropriations

SB 2120 (SO) by Senator Joyner and others—


