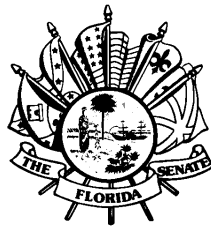

### BILLS ON THIRD READING

#### **CS/CS/CS/SB 1928 (3R) by the Committees on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations, Governmental Operations, Transportation and the Committee on Transportation (Baker)—**

**Transportation/M.P.O.'s**; requires commission to monitor transportation authorities & conduct periodic reviews of each authority; authorizes metropolitan planning orgs. & certain separate entities to establish per diem & travel reimbursement rates; defines term "metropolitan planning organization" for purposes of FRS Act; providing for creation of transportation concurrency backlog authorities; renames charter county transit system surtax, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 30, 2007, and read the third time on May 2, 2007*

*Compare to **CS/CS/HB 985 (HC)** in Messages*

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#### **CS/CS/SB 2250 (3R) by the Committees on Governmental Operations, Military Affairs and Domestic Security, Senator Deutch and others—**

**Iran/Divestment of Public Funds**; requires SBA to identify all companies doing certain types of business in or with Iran in which public moneys are invested; requires SBA to create & maintain Scrutinized Company List that names all such companies; requires board to divest company of all publicly traded securities of said company under certain conditions; provides for expiration of act; requires certain information to be included in investment policy statement, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Read the second time and amended on May 2, 2007*

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#### **CS/HB 397 (3R) by the Healthcare Council, Representative Anderson and others—**

**Caregivers for Adults**; authorizes DOEA to create pilot program in specified counties to train persons to act as companions & provide certain services to frail adults in community; specifies additional purposes of pilot program; requires evaluation & report to Legislature. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 434 (SUB)** (Jones), read the second time and amended on May 2, 2007*

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#### **CS/SB 606 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax and Senator Geller—**

**S. Fla. Reg. Transportation Auth.**; revises provisions re powers & duties of South Florida Regional Transportation Authority; authorizes authority to issue, reissue, or redeem certain bonds; requires authority to sell such bonds at public sale; authorizes authority to enter into trust indentures or other agreements & to assign & pledge revenues, fees, rentals, tolls, & other charges, etc. Amends 343.54, .55, .58. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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#### **CS/HB 1269 (3R) by the Healthcare Council, Representative Reed and others—**

**Infant Mortality**; provides legislative intent re black infant health practice initiative; requires local community to develop team to serve as part of statewide practice collaborative; requires healthy start coalitions to conduct case reviews; requires certain public universities or colleges to provide technical assistance, to assist in determining certain criteria, & to present findings & make recommendations, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **SB 2120 (SUB)** (Joyner) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/HB 1405 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council and Representative Bullard—**

**Pub. Rec./U.S. Dept. of Labor/National Landmark;** creates exemption from public records requirements for information that identifies donor or prospective donor to publicly owned house museum designated by United States Department of the Interior as National Historic Landmark who desires to remain anonymous; provides for future legislative review & repeal of exemption under OGSR; provides statement of public necessity. Creates 267.076. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 2772 (SUB)** (Bullard) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/HB 981 (3R) by the Environment & Natural Resources Council and Representative Culp—**

**State Parks/Rule Violations;** requires that certain violations of rules of Recreation & Parks Division of DEP are punishable as noncriminal infractions; requires that active member of Florida National Guard, or dependent of such member, be charged only half price of admission to state park; authorizes Legislature to appropriate funds from Land Acquisition Trust Fund for use as matching funds for capital improvement facility development, etc. Amends Chs. 258, 259, 316. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 94 (SUB)** (Baker), read the second time and amended on May 2, 2007*

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**HB 7169 (3R) by the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council, Representative Reagan and others—**

**Pub. Records & Meetings Exemptions/Workers' Comp.;** provides exemption from public records requirements for certain records of Fla. Workers' Compensation Joint Underwriting Association, Inc.; authorizes release of confidential & exempt records under certain circumstances; provides exemption from public meetings requirements for portions of meeting of association's board of governors or subcommittee thereof during which confidential & exempt records are discussed, etc. Creates 627.3121. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 628 (SUB)** (Lawson) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**HB 7203 (3R) by the Economic Expansion & Infrastructure Council, Representatives Cannon and Kravitz—**

**Growth Management;** revises certain criteria & requirements for elements of comprehensive plans; revises application of concurrency requirements to public transit facilities; provides for creation of transportation concurrency backlog authorities; provides for issuance of revenue bonds for certain purposes; provides for pilot program to provide plan review process for certain densely developed areas; provides legislative findings, etc. Amends Ch. 163, 380.06. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 800 (SUB)** (Garcia), read the second time and amended on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/HB 7123 (3R) by the Policy & Budget Council, the Environment & Natural Resources Council, Representatives Mayfield, Allen and others—**

**Energy;** revises provisions for renewable energy source exemption; excludes assessed value of certain real property for determination of such exemption; increases cap on sales tax exemption for materials used in distribution of biodiesel & ethanol fuels; establishes Energy-Efficient Motor Vehicle Sales Tax Holiday; establishes Green Schools Pilot Project to enable selected school districts to comply with certain building-certification standards, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/CS/SB's 996 & CS/SB 2666 (SUB)** (Bennett), read the second time and amended on May 2, 2007*

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**HB 7127 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council and Representative Attkisson—**

**OGSR/PEORP/Identifying Information;** amends provision which provides exemption from public records requirements for personal identifying information of participant in PEORP contained in FRS records held by State Board of Administration or DMS; makes editorial changes; removes superfluous provisions; removes scheduled repeal of exemption under OGSR. Amends 121.4501. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

*Substituted for **SB 1492 (SUB)** (Lawson) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**HB 7077 (3R) by the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council and Representative Reagan—**

**Insurance;** revises certain reimbursement contract requirements; deletes expiration provision re obtaining coverage for liquidated insurers; limits application of certain annual report card preparation powers of consumer advocate to personal residential property insurers; specifies separate coverage exclusion statements for policyholders that are natural persons & other than natural persons, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 1866 (SUB)** (Posey) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/HB 1285 (3R) by the Safety & Security Council and Representative Altman—**

**Construction Liens;** requires performance bond for certain contracts with private entities for specified public works projects; revises requirements re when claimants must provide certain notices; requires that certain notices pertaining to direct contracts greater than \$2,500 for improvements to certain property be in writing; provides that failure of person to make specified statement under oath deprives person of lien, etc. Amends Ch. 713, 255.05. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 2768 (SUB)** (Aronberg) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/HB 1 (3R) by the Safety & Security Council and Representative Peterman—**

**Drug-related Task Forces;** creates Drug Paraphernalia Abatement Task Force within Executive Office of Governor; prescribes task force membership; provides for meetings & duties; provides that meetings & records of task force are subject to statutory public meetings & records requirements; creates within Executive Office of Governor Task Force for Remediation of Illicit Drug Labs; requires that task force file reports & recommendations to Governor & Legislature, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Substituted for **CS/SB 270 (SUB)** (Lynn) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**HB 7145 (3R) by the Schools & Learning Council, Representative Pickens and others—**

**Scholarship Programs;** amends provisions re Corporate Income Tax Credit Scholarship Prog.; revises program purposes; revises provisions re authorized uses of scholarship funds & expenditure of contributions received during fiscal year; amends provisions re John M. McKay Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Prog.; revises DOE obligations re cross-check of student enrollment; requires private school to employ case manager, etc. Amends 220.187, 1002.39. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/SB 2380 (SUB)** (Webster), read the second time and amended on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/HB 1047 (3R) by the Jobs & Entrepreneurship Council, Representative Seiler and others—**

**Slot Machine Gaming;** defines term "nonredeemable credits"; redefines term "slot machine revenues"; exempts slot machine manufacturers & distributors, certain educational facilities, the division, & FDLE from certain prohibitions against possessing slot machines at place other than licensee's facility under certain circumstances; revises prohibition against cashing checks to allow cashing checks outside designated slot machine gaming area, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/SB 2148 (3R) by the Committee on Commerce, Senator Deutch and others—**

**Limited Liability Companies/Name;** eliminates authorization to use the words "limited company," abbreviation "L.C.," or designation "L.C." as company name; requires limited liability company name to be distinguishable on databases maintained by Corporations Div. of Department of State; provides exception; requires name of limited liability company in company's articles of organization to satisfy certain requirements. Amends 608.406,.407. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**HB 1155 (3R) by Representative Glorioso and others—**

**Drugs;** requires pharmacies doing business by Internet to receive, display, & maintain specified certifying seal of approval; provides that use or possession of drug paraphernalia with intent to undertake certain activities concerning manufacture or production of methamphetamine is felony of second degree; prohibits sale, manufacture, alteration, delivery, uttering, or possession of counterfeit-resistant prescription blanks, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

*Substituted for **CS/CS/SB 518 (SUB)** (Saunders), read the second time and amended on May 2, 2007*

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**HB 1421 (3R) by Representative Brise and others—**

**Digital Divide Council;** recreates council in DOE; revises membership of council; provides for terms of office; requires initial meeting & at specified times thereafter; conforms references; deletes requirements for certain pilot programs; provides objectives of council; requires annual report to Governor & Legislature. Amends 445.049. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Substituted for **SB 2304 (SUB)** (Wilson) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/CS/SB 432 (3R) by the Committees on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations, Commerce, Senator King and others—**

**Transportation/Seaports;** revises funding for certain dredging projects; revises distribution of license tax moneys deposited in State Transportation TF for funding of Fla. Seaport Transportation & Economic Development Program & certain seaport intermodal access projects; requires Fla. Seaport Transportation & Economic Development Council to submit list of certain freight mobility projects to DOT; creates Fla. Seaport Finance Corporation, etc. Amends Ch. 311, 320.20. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/SB 2176 (3R) by the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation and Senator Bennett—**

**Inland Navigation Districts;** provides that operation & maintenance by inland navigation districts of intracoastal waterway & certain other public navigation channels are in public interest; adds nonmember counties that contain any part of said waterway within their boundaries to list of governmental entities with which district can aid & cooperate; authorizes DEP to develop & maintain list of flocculants for certain uses, etc. Amends 374.975,.976, 403.813. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/CS/HB 359 (3R) by the Policy & Budget Council, the Economic Expansion & Infrastructure Council, Representative Kriseman and others—**

**Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility;** requires proof of increased fin. responsibility for bodily injury or death caused by owners or operators found guilty of, or who entered plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, regardless of adjudication of guilt, DUI offense or who had license or driving privilege revoked or suspended; prohibits insurer from taking certain actions solely because insured or specified person serves as volunteer driver for nonprofit agency or charitable org., etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Substituted for CS/CS/SB 846 (SUB) (Jones) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/HB 1315 (3R) by the Government Efficiency & Accountability Council, Representative Hasner and others—**

**Broward & Palm Beach Counties' Boundaries;** extends & enlarges boundaries of Broward Co. to include certain lands in Palm Beach Co.; decreases boundaries of Palm Beach Co.; extends & enlarges corporate boundaries of City of Parkland in Broward Co. to annex specified unincorporated lands; supersedes specified special acts re annexation of unincorporated areas into municipalities; provides for payment or apportionment of public debt, etc. Amends 7.06,.50. Effective Date: Contingent.

*Substituted for CS/SB 2752 (SUB) (Ring) and read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/SB 2534 (3R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Aronberg and others—**

**Voyeurism/Video;** provides that it is third-degree felony for certain persons who are responsible for welfare of child younger than 16 years of age to commit offense of video voyeurism, video voyeurism dissemination or commercial video voyeurism dissemination against that child; provides that it is third-degree felony for person employed at school to commit offense of said voyeurism against student of school, etc. Amends 810.145. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/SB 1152 (3R) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Carlton—**

**Florida Government Accountability Act;** provides for Senate & House of Representatives to jointly appoint Legislative Sunset Advisory Committee to oversee review process required under act; revises schedule for reviewing state agencies & advisory committees; revises duties of OPPAGA; requires said committee to propose legislation if necessary; authorizes committee to exercise any powers vested in standing committee of Legislature, etc. Amends Ch. 11. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on May 2, 2007*

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**CS/SB 1020 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Haridopolos and others—**

**Ad Valorem Taxation;** requires that property appraiser provide instructions to taxing authorities for computing rolled-back rate; provides that certain tax increment finance payments, taxes levied for payment of bonds, & voted tax levies are exempt from limitations on millage rates; amends specified provisions re taxpayer rights, approval of assessment rolls, disclosure of tax impact, & school district taxes, etc. Amends Chs. 192, 193, 194, 200, 218, 1011. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 19, 2007*

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**CS/SJR 3034 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Atwater and others—**

**Ad Valorem Taxation/Tangible Personal Property;** constitutional amendment to authorize, by general law, exemption from ad valorem taxation of up to \$25,000 of assessed value on each tangible personal property tax return & to schedule amendment to take effect on January 1, 2009; to provide that assessed value of new homestead must equal or exceed assessed value of previous homestead, etc. Amends ss. 3, 4, 6, Art. VII; creates new section, Art. XII.

*Read the second time on April 19, 2007*

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**CS/SB 1022 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax, Senator Haridopolos and others—**

**Affordable Housing;** requires appraisers to use income approach when assessing affordable housing property that has low-income tax credit; provides for just valuation of affordable housing property; requires property appraisers to use income approach when assessing such property; specifies kinds of property subject to assessment. Amends 193.017; creates 193.018. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time on April 19, 2007*

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**CS/CS/SB 560 (3R) by the Committees on Finance and Tax, Community Affairs, Senator Atwater and others—**

**Local Governments;** requires that value of expected future tax benefits for homestead property be compensated for in eminent domain taking; requires that county, municipality, or special district hold certain public hearings before adopting ordinance or resolution increasing impact fee; specified data to be used for tabulating property value & taxation including information concerning ad valorem taxes & millage rates, etc. Amends Ch. 73, 163.31801, 193.011, 195.052, 200.069. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

*Read the second time and amended on April 19, 2007*

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**CS/CS/SB 1982 (3R) by the Committees on  
General Government Appropriations,  
Environmental Preservation and Conservation  
and the Committee on Environmental  
Preservation and Conservation (Saunders)—**

**Recreational Licenses & Permits/FWC;** authorizes FWC, tax collectors, & certain subagents to request & collect donations when selling recreational license or permit; revises exemption under which resident need not possess license in order to fish in salt water from land or from structure fixed to land; requires commission to provide to Governor & Legislature report on activities funded from sale of snook permits; corrects reference to spiny lobster, etc. Amends Ch. 372. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

### **CS/SB 2084 (SO) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Bennett—**

**Health Care Services;** authorizes certain licensed entities to offer health flex plan; establishes small business health insurance plan grant program; requires ID card containing specified information to be given to insureds who have health & accident insurance; requires ID card containing specified information to be given to insureds under group health insurance policies & to persons having health care services through health maintenance contract, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 01/01/2008 except as otherwise provided.

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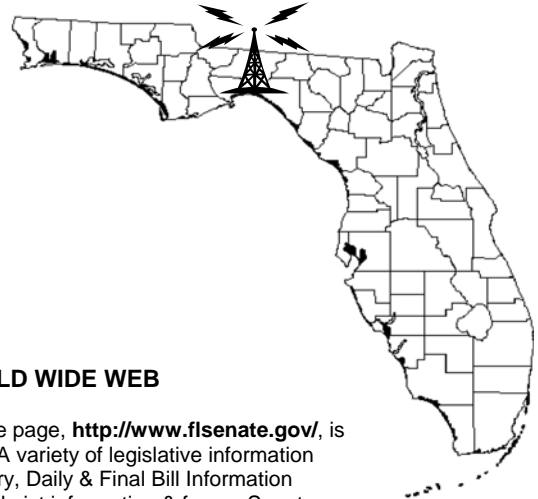
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
