## BILLS ON THIRD READING

## FISCAL POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [FPCC] GROUPING

#### SB 4-D (3R) by Senator Atwater and others—

Ad Valorem Taxation; Specifies circumstances under which the presumption concerning the correctness of an ad valorem tax assessment is lost. Provides for the rate of percentage change of a category of property comprised of comparable property. Increases the amount of the exemption provided for homestead property. Provides the exemption as a first-time Florida homebuyer to a member of the U.S. Armed Services under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 01/01/2008 except as otherwise provided.

Introduced Inside the Call on October 15, 2007.— Read the second time and amended on October 17, 2007

#### SB 6-D (3R) by Senator Constantine—


Special Election/Ad Valorem Taxation; Provides for a special election to be held January 29, 2008, for the approval or rejection by the electors of amendments to the State Constitution proposed in Senate Joint Resolution 2-D or House Joint Resolution 7001-D. Provides for the publication of notice and for procedures, etc. Effective Date: Contingent.
