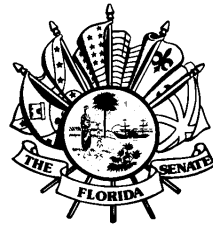

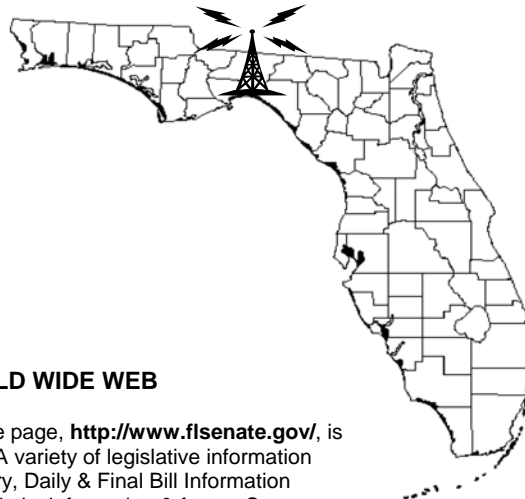

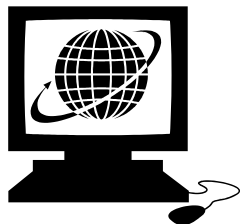
TELEVISION COVERAGE
