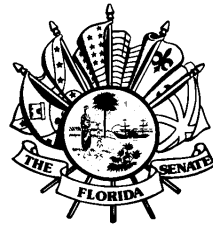

POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY [CPSC] GROUPING

SB 318 (3R) by Senator Sobel and others—

Criminal Usury Laws/Discriminatory Language; Removes the term "shylocking" from certain provisions of state law relating to loan sharking. Deletes the terms "shylock" and "shylocking" from the definitions of "loan shark" and "loan sharking," respectively, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

SB 316 (3R) by Senator Constantine and others—

High School Diplomas/Vietnam War Veterans; Authorizes the Commissioner of Education to award a high school diploma to honorably discharged Vietnam War veterans. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY [CPSC] GROUPING

CS/CS/SB 1062 (2R) by the Committees on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations, Commerce and Senator Fasano—

Unemployment Compensation; Redefines the term "employee leasing company" to reflect reporting requirements imposed by the act. Requires an employee leasing company to submit a report regarding its establishments to the Labor Market Statistics Center within the Agency for Workforce Innovation. Provides reporting requirements. Requires the agency to adopt rules. Provides definitions. Effective Date: 10/01/2009.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations

POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS [GPSC] GROUPING

SB 252 (2R) by Senator Constantine and others—

Local Government/Code of Ethics; Specifies standards of conduct for officers and employees of entities serving as the chief administrative officer of a political subdivision. Provides for penalties to be imposed against persons other than lobbyists or public officers and employers for violations of the Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees. Provides for the Commission of Ethics to report to the Governor violations involving persons other than lobbyists, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably by the Committees on Ethics and Elections, and Governmental Oversight and Accountability

POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY [SPSC] GROUPING

CS/CS/SB 552 (2R) by the Committees on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations, Health Regulation and Senator Wise—

Prescribed Pancreatic Enzyme Supplements/Use; Authorizes certain K-12 students to use prescribed pancreatic enzyme supplements under certain circumstances. Requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules. Provides for indemnification. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health Regulation and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations

CS/SB 620 (2R) by the Committee on Health Regulation and Senator Oelrich—

Health Facilities; Redefines the term "health facility" for the purpose of allowing additional types of health facilities to receive assistance from a health facilities authority. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health Regulation and the Committee on Community Affairs reports the committee substitute favorably

CS/SB 702 (2R) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Gaetz—

Health Care Access; Expands the membership of the board of directors of the Florida Healthy Kids Corporation. Specifies certain provider arrangement contract prohibitions or restrictions. Prohibits prepaid limited health service organizations from specifying certain contract continuation or renewal conditions. Provides for application to HMOs of the prohibition against specifying certain contract continuation or renewal conditions, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably, with two amendments, by the Committee on Health Regulation and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, and the Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations, reports the committee substitute favorably

CS/SB 1312 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice and Senator Fasano—

Sexual Battery; Requires each law enforcement officer who investigates an alleged sexual battery incident to assist the victim in obtaining medical treatment if medical treatment is necessary, a forensic examination, and crisis-intervention services from a certified rape crisis center. Requires the law enforcement officer to immediately notify the victim of the legal rights and remedies available to a victim of sexual battery, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice

SB 1084 (2R) by Senator Crist—

Federal Grants Trust Fund/FDLE; Re-creates the Federal Grants Trust Fund within the Department of Law Enforcement without modification. Abrogates provisions relating to the termination of the trust fund, to conform. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

SB 1086 (2R) by Senator Crist—

Federal Grants Trust Fund/State Courts System; Re-creates the Federal Grants Trust Fund within the state courts system without modification. Abrogates provisions relating to the termination of the trust fund, to conform. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

SB 1090 (2R) by Senator Crist—

Federal Grants Trust Fund/DOC; Re-creates the Federal Grants Trust Fund within the Department of Corrections without modification. Abrogates provisions relating to the termination of the trust fund, to conform. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

SB 1092 (2R) by Senator Crist—

Federal Grants Trust Fund/Parole Commission; Re-creates the Federal Grants Trust Fund within the Florida Parole Commission without modification. Abrogates provisions relating to the termination of the trust fund, to conform. Effective Date: 07/01/2009.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

SB 1106 (2R) by Senator Crist—

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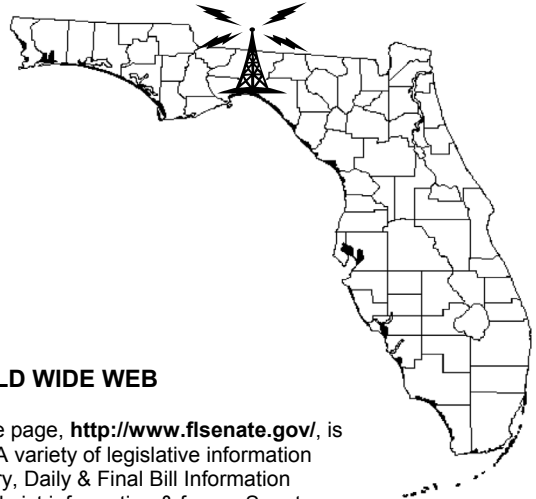
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
