#### **CS/SB 4 (SO) by the Committee on Appropriations, Senator Galvano and others—**

**Higher Education;** Citing this act as the "Florida Excellence in Higher Education Act of 2018"; establishing the World Class Faculty and Scholar Program; authorizing state university investments in certain faculty retention, recruitment, and recognition activities; establishing the State University Professional and Graduate Degree Excellence Program; authorizing students to use certain Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program awards for summer term enrollment beginning in specified years; extending coverage of the Benacquisto Scholarship Program to include tuition and fees for qualified nonresident students, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Education; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Higher Education; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

#### **CS/SB 88 (SO) by the Committee on Education, Senator Hukill and others—**

**High School Graduation Requirements;** Revising the requirements for the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards to include financial literacy; revising the required credits for a standard high school diploma to include one-half credit of instruction in personal financial literacy and money management and seven and one-half, rather than eight, credits in electives, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education; Appropriations Subcommittee on Pre-K - 12 Education recommends the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*
