Appropriations; Providing moneys for the annual period beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, and supplemental appropriations for the period ending June 30, 2019, to pay salaries, and other expenses, capital outlay - buildings, and other improvements, and for other specified purposes of the various agencies of state government, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise provided herein, this act shall take effect July 1, 2019, or upon becoming law, whichever occurs later; however, if this act becomes law after July 1, 2019, then it shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2019

# SB 2502 (SO) by the Committee on Appropriations (Bradley)—

#### Implementing the 2019-2020 General Appropriations Act;

**State Employees;** Providing for the resolution of collective bargaining issues at impasse between the state and certified bargaining units of state employees, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2019

# SB 7016 (SO) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Hooper)—

State-administered Retirement Systems; Revising required employer retirement contribution rates for each membership class and subclass of the Florida Retirement System, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2019

# CS/CS/SB 234 (SO) by the Committees on Judiciary, Infrastructure and Security and Senator Baxley—

Registration and Titling of Vehicles and Vessels; Revising registration periods for certain vehicles; requiring the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to prorate registration renewals for customers in order to implement changes made by the act; authorizing the department or its agent to verify necessary information through the electronic file of death records maintained by the Department of Health for a surviving spouse of a motor vehicle owner when requesting a registration certificate and license plate transfer, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2019

### SB 320 (SO) by Senator Hooper—

**Residential Conservation Programs**; Authorizing the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission to organize, staff, equip, and operate residential conservation programs for a specified purpose, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2019

Reported favorably by the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations

### CS/CS/SB 366 (SO) by the Committees on Appropriations, Health Policy, Senator Braynon and others—

Infectious Disease Elimination Programs; Citing this act as the "Infectious Disease Elimination Act (IDEA)"; providing that a county commission may authorize a sterile needle and syringe exchange program; requiring the development of an oversight and accountability system for certain purposes; providing for immunity from civil liability, under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2019

### CS/SB 592 (SO) by the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Albritton—

**Prescription Drug Monitoring Program**; Expanding the exceptions to a requirement that a prescriber or dispenser must consult the program to review a patient's controlled substance dispensing history before prescribing or dispensing a controlled substance for a patient of a certain age, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2019
