### BILLS ON THIRD READING

#### **CS/SB 102, 1st Eng. (3R) by the Committee on Reapportionment and Senator Rodrigues—**

**Establishing the Congressional Districts of the State;** Adopting the United States Decennial Census of 2020 as the official census of the state for use in redistricting the state's congressional districts; redistricting the state's congressional districts in accordance with the United States Decennial Census of 2020 (plan S000C8040); providing for the inclusion of unlisted territory in contiguous districts in accordance with figures from the United States Decennial Census of 2020; specifying that certain electronic maps serve as the official maps of the congressional districts of the state; requiring such maps to be made available to the public by the Office of Economic and Demographic Research within a specified timeframe, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect upon the expiration of the terms of the representatives to the United States House of Representatives serving on the date that this act becomes a law

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#### **CS/SJR 100 (3R) by the Committee on Reapportionment and Senator Rodrigues—**

**Joint Resolution of Apportionment;** Providing for the apportionment of the House of Representatives and the Senate (plans \_\_\_\_\_ and S027S8058); adopting the United States Decennial Census of 2020 for use in such apportionment; providing for the inclusion of omitted areas; providing contiguity for areas specified for inclusion in one district which are noncontiguous; specifying that the apportioned districts constitute the legislative districts of the state; specifying that electronic maps serve as the official maps of the legislative districts of the state; providing for the public availability of electronic maps, etc.

### SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

#### **SB 156 (2R) by Senator Broxson—**

**Loss Run Statements;** Specifying the entities that must receive requests for loss run statements; specifying that insurers must provide loss run statements under certain circumstances; revising the required claims history in loss run statements; providing applicability; limiting loss run statement requests with respect to group health insurance policies to group policyholders, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

#### **CS/SM 174 (2R) by the Committee on Commerce and Tourism, Senator Pizzo and others—**

**Trade;** Urging Congress to expeditiously renew trade promotion authority for the executive branch, urging the executive branch to negotiate a comprehensive and mutually beneficial free trade agreement between the United States and the United Kingdom, and urging Congress to ratify such agreement, etc.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce and Tourism; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

#### **CS/SB 254 (2R) by the Committee on Rules, Senator Brodeur and others—**

**Religious Institutions;** Defining the term "religious institution"; providing that an emergency order may not directly or indirectly prohibit religious services or activities; providing an exception under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2022

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules*

**SM 302 (2R) by Senator Burgess and others—**

**Recognizing Veteran Suicide;** Urging Congress to recognize the epidemic of suicide among veterans and to fully fund suicide prevention efforts of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, etc.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 312 (2R) by Senator Diaz—**

**Telehealth;** Revising the definition of the term “telehealth”; narrowing the prohibition on prescribing controlled substances through telehealth to include only specified controlled substances, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2022

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Health Policy; reported favorably by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*
