## BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

### BILLS ON THIRD READING

#### **SB 2-C, 1st Eng. (3R) by Senator Rodrigues—**

**Establishing the Congressional Districts of the State;** Adopting the United States Decennial Census of 2020 as the official census of the state for use in redistricting the state's congressional districts; redistricting the state's congressional districts in accordance with the United States Decennial Census of 2020 (plan P000C0109); providing for the inclusion of unlisted territory in contiguous districts in accordance with figures from the United States Decennial Census of 2020; specifying that certain electronic maps serve as the official maps of the congressional districts of the state; requiring such maps to be made available to the public by the Office of Economic and Demographic Research within a specified timeframe; requiring actions challenging the state's congressional districts to be brought in a specific venue; specifying limitations for actions challenging the state's congressional districts, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect upon the expiration of the terms of the representatives to the United States House of Representatives serving on the date that this act becomes a law

#### **SB 4-C (3R) by Senator Bradley—**

**Independent Special Districts;** Dissolving certain independent special districts; authorizing the reestablishment of certain independent special districts, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2022

**Social Media Platforms;** Revising the definition of the term "social media platform", etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
