Health Care Practitioner Titles and Designations; Providing that, for specified purposes, the use of specified titles or designations in connection with one's name constitutes the practice of medicine or the practice of osteopathic medicine; revising grounds for disciplinary action relating to a practitioner's use of such titles or designations in identifying himself or herself to patients or in advertisements for health care services; requiring certain health care practitioners to prominently display a copy of their license in a conspicuous area of their practice, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

### SB 144 (SO) by Senator Berman—

**Lactation Spaces**; Requiring each county courthouse to provide at least one lactation space for members of the public by a specified date; providing requirements for such lactation space; authorizing the use of state or private funds to provide lactation spaces in appellate courthouses; providing exceptions, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

# CS/SB 360 (SO) by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator Hutson—

### Causes of Action Based on Improvements to Real Property;

Revising the time in which an action founded on the design, planning, or construction of an improvement to real property must be commenced; revising the date on which the statute of limitations period begins; providing for the calculation of the statute of limitations period for multi-dwelling buildings, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

### SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

CS/SB 150 (2R) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy, Senator Collins and others—

Public Safety; Requiring sheriffs to assist private schools in complying with a certain statute; authorizing a person to carry a concealed weapon or concealed firearm if he or she is licensed to do so or meets specified requirements; specifying that the state bears the burden of proof for certain violations; requiring a person who is carrying a concealed weapon or concealed firearm without a license to carry valid identification and display such identification upon demand by a law enforcement officer; providing that a person who is authorized to carry a concealed weapon or concealed firearm without a license is subject to specified penalties for possessing such weapon or firearm at a school-sponsored event or on school property; requiring the Office of Safe Schools to develop a behavioral threat management operational process by a specified date; authorizing a private school to partner with a law enforcement agency or security agency for specified purposes, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect July 1, 2023

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal Justice; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### SB 152 (2R) by Senator Collins-

Public Records/Safe-school Officer at a Private School; Providing a public records exemption for information pertaining to a safe-school officer at a private school; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: On the same date that SB 150 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal Justice; and reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

CS/SM 160 (2R) by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security, Senator Avila and others—

Redesignation of the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC) as a Foreign Terrorist Organization; Urging the United States Secretary of State to redesignate the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC) as a Foreign Terrorist Organization pursuant to section 219 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended, etc.

Interscholastic Extracurricular Activities; Authorizing charter school students and Florida Virtual School full-time students to participate in extracurricular activities at a private school under certain circumstances; authorizing charter school students to participate in interscholastic extracurricular activities at a private school under certain circumstances; authorizing charter school students and Florida Virtual School full-time program students to participate in interscholastic extracurricular activities at a private school under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

## CS/SB 204 (2R) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy, Senator Rouson and others—

Task Force on the Monitoring of Children in Out-of-Home Care; Creating the task force adjunct to the Department of Law Enforcement; specifying the purpose of the task force; specifying duties of the task force; requiring the Florida Institute for Child Welfare to conduct certain focus groups and individual interviews and submit its findings to the task force by a specified date; providing for future review and repeal, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

Reported favorably by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

### SB 274 (2R) by Senator Avila and others-

Nursing Education Pathway for Military Combat Medics; Revising a primary goal of the Florida Center for Nursing to provide that development of a statewide plan for nursing manpower must include the encouragement and coordination of the development of partnerships with hospitals which provide opportunities for nursing students to obtain clinical experience; requiring that the Articulation Coordinating Committee convene a workgroup to establish a process for determining postsecondary course equivalencies and the minimum postsecondary credit or career education clock hours that must be awarded in accredited nursing education programs for military training and education required for service in specified positions; authorizing the award of additional postsecondary credit or career education clock hours, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
