BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

BILLS ON THIRD READING

HB 7063 (3R) by the Committee on Ways & Means Committee and Representative McClain—

Taxation; Revises provisions related to taxation including tourist tax reimbursement, homestead exemptions, exemptions for religious & educational property, refunds of certain property taxes, discretionary sales surtaxes, taxes on certain loans, surtaxes found to be unconstitutional, exemptions from sales & use taxes, tax on rental & license fees, tax credits for certain systems & equipment & Strong Families tax credits. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

*Substituted for **CS/SB 7062(SUB)** (Ingoglia), read the second time, and amended on May 4, 2023*

SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

CS/CS/SB 464 (2R) by the Appropriations Committee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development, the Committee on Transportation and Senator Perry—

Interstate Safety; Defining the term “furthestmost left-hand lane”; prohibiting a driver from operating a motor vehicle in the furthestmost left-hand lane of certain roadways, except under certain circumstances; providing a penalty, etc. Effective Date: 01/01/2024

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Appropriations Committee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development; and the Committee on Fiscal Policy reports the committee substitute favorably

CS/CS/SB 516 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Banking and Insurance and Senator DiCeglie—

Motor Vehicle Liability Policies; Revising the definition of the term “motor vehicle liability policy” and defining the term “risk retention group” for purposes of ch. 324, F.S., etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; the Appropriations Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice reports the committee substitute favorably; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules

CS/CS/CS/SB 564 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Commerce and Tourism, Banking and Insurance and Senator Hutson—

Interchange Fees on Taxes; Prohibiting issuers, payment card networks, acquirer banks, and processors from receiving or charging merchants interchange fees on the tax amounts of electronic payment transactions if the merchant provides certain information in a specified manner; requiring an issuer to credit a merchant the amount of interchange fees on taxes within a certain timeframe if the merchant meets certain conditions; prohibiting specified actions relating to electronic payment transaction data by certain entities, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce and Tourism; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules

CS/CS/SB 760 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Transportation and Senator Perry—

Towing and Storage; Prohibiting the Division of the Florida Highway Patrol from excluding wrecker operators from the wrecker operator system or from being designated as an authorized wrecker operator based solely on a prior felony conviction; authorizing a towing-storage operator to charge certain fees; revising the timeframe in which certain unclaimed vehicles or vessels may be sold; revising requirements for the sale or disposition of property at self-service storage facilities, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation; the Committee on Community Affairs reports the committee substitute favorably; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules

CS/SB 1040 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Senator Burgess—

District School Board Direct-support Organizations; Authorizing district school boards to contract with direct-support organizations for personal services or operations, subject to certain limitations; revising the amount of expenditures and expenses a direct-support organization must have to be required to provide for an annual financial audit; authorizing district school boards to contract with a vendor for such audits, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2023

Reported favorably by the Committee on Education Pre-K -12; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably

CS/CS/SB 1084 (2R) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy, the Appropriations Committee on Health and Human Services and Senator Trumbull—

Pilot Program for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities; Requiring the Agency for Health Care Administration to implement a pilot program for individuals with developmental disabilities residing in specified Statewide Medicaid Managed Care regions to provide coverage of comprehensive services; authorizing the agency to seek federal approval as needed to implement the program; providing that participation in the pilot program is voluntary and subject to specific appropriation; requiring the Agency for Persons with Disabilities to approve a needs assessment methodology for prospective enrollees, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

Reported favorably by the Committee on Health Policy; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Appropriations Committee on Health and Human Services; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

CS/CS/SB 1252 (2R) by the Committees on Fiscal Policy, Transportation and Senator DiCeglie—

Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; Requiring the department or its authorized agent to issue certain licenses and fuel tax decals; providing that a certain affidavit constitutes proof of ownership and right of possession to a motor vehicle or mobile home the previous owner of which died testate; authorizing permanent registration of certain rental trucks; authorizing a uniform paper or electronic format of the registration certificate for a motor vehicle; requiring that certain information on the driver license or identification card of a sexual offender or sexual predator be printed in red; requiring the department to record in the driver's record that he or she is disqualified from operating a commercial motor vehicle under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2023

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation; the Appropriations Committee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development reports the committee substitute favorably; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

CS/CS/SB 1366 (2R) by the Appropriations Committee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government, the Committee on Regulated Industries and Senator Collins—

Fees/Interstate-Mobility and Universal-Recognition Occupational Licensing Act; Authorizing applicable boards to charge a fee for applications under the Interstate-Mobility and Universal-Recognition Occupational Licensing Act, etc. Effective Date: On the same date that SB 1364 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Regulated Industries; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Appropriations Committee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government; and the Committee on Fiscal Policy reports the committee substitute favorably

SR 1728 (2R) by Senator Collins and others—

Tyrannical Cuban Government; Condemning the tyrannical Cuban government and the Tampa City Council member and Hillsborough County officials who, on March 3, 2023, entertained the Cuban ambassador and other Cuban officials at a dinner meeting in Tampa in complete disregard of the brutality of the Cuban regime and the blood that has been shed by those who rose up in opposition, etc.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Rules

FIRST PUBLICATION ON SECOND READING

CS/CS/CS/SB 1364 (2R1) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy, the Appropriations Committee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government, the Committee on Regulated Industries, Senator Collins and others—

Interstate-Mobility and Universal-Recognition Occupational Licensing Act; Designating the "Interstate-Mobility and Universal-Recognition Occupational Licensing Act"; requiring certain agencies, boards, departments, and other governmental entities to issue an occupational license or a government certification to applicants under certain circumstances; authorizing such entities to require an applicant to pass a specified examination under certain circumstances; requiring licensing entities to provide a written decision to an applicant within a specified timeframe; authorizing the Governor to take certain actions relating to occupational licenses during declared states of emergency, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2024

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Regulated Industries; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Appropriations Committee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Fiscal Policy
