January 9, 2024	Regular Session convenes (Article III, section 3(b), State Constitution) 12:00 noon — Deadline to file bills for introduction (Senate Rule 3.7(1))
February 24, 2024	Motion to reconsider made and considered the same day (Senate Rule 6.4(4)) All bills are immediately certified (Senate Rule 6.8)
February 27, 2024	50 th day — Last day for regularly scheduled committee meetings (Senate Rule 2.9(2))
March 8, 2024	60 th day — Last day of Regular Session (Article III, section 3(d), State Constitution)

BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

SPECIAL ORDER CALENDAR FOR WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2023

SB 2-C (SO) by Senator Simon—

Disaster Relief; Providing a tangible personal property assessment limitation, during a certain timeframe and in certain counties, for certain agricultural equipment rendered unable to be used due to Hurricane Idalia; providing a sales tax exemption for the purchase, within a certain timeframe and in certain counties, of certain fencing materials used to replace or repair fences damaged by Hurricane Idalia on agricultural lands; specifying a requirement for the Department of Financial Services in implementing the My Safe Florida Home Program; extending the date for future review and repeal of provisions related to the Florida Emergency Management Assistance Foundation, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

Reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

Similar to CS/HB 1-C(HC) in the Committee on Fiscal Policy

SB 4-C (SO) by Senator Collins—

Family Empowerment Scholarship Program; Revising the number of certain students eligible to participate in the Family Empowerment Scholarship Program, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

Reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

Identical to HB 3-C(HC) in the Committee on Fiscal Policy

SB 6-C (SO) by Senator Calatayud—

Security Grants; Expanding the Nonprofit Security Grant Program to include additional organizations; revising eligibility criteria to be awarded a grant; requiring that certain rules be adopted by the Division of Emergency Management, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

Reported favorably by the Committee on Fiscal Policy

Similar to CS/HB 7-C(HC) in the Committee on Fiscal Policy

SR 8-C (SO) by Senator Berman—

Support for the State of Israel; Expressing support for the State of Israel and condemning the attacks and hateful actions by the Hamas terrorist group, etc.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Rules

SB 10-C (SO) by Senator Avila—

Scrutinized Companies; Revising the definition of the term "scrutinized company"; requiring the State Board of Administration to identify and maintain the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Iran Terrorism Sectors List; providing that companies on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List as of a specified date are deemed, beginning on a certain date, to be on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Iran Terrorism Sectors List until removed pursuant to specified procedures; providing that certain entities are ineligible to, and may not, bid on, submit a proposal for, or enter into or renew certain contracts, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

Reported favorably by the Committee on Rules

Identical to HB 5-C(HC) in the Committee on Rules
