### SB 14 (2R) by Senator Rodriguez—

**Relief of Jose Correa by Miami-Dade County;** Providing for the relief of Jose Correa by Miami-Dade County; providing an appropriation to compensate Mr. Correa for injuries sustained as a result of the negligence of an employee of Miami-Dade County; providing a limitation on the payment of compensation and certain fees, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Recommended favorably by the Special Master on Claim Bills; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### SB 16 (2R) by Senator Rouson—

**Relief of Heriberto A. Sanchez-Mayen by the City of St. Petersburg;** Providing for the relief of Heriberto A. Sanchez-Mayen by the City of St. Petersburg; providing for an appropriation to compensate Mr. Sanchez-Mayen for injuries sustained as a result of the negligence of the City of St. Petersburg; providing a limitation on compensation and the payment of attorney fees, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Recommended favorably by the Special Master on Claim Bills; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### SB 24 (2R) by Senator Gruters and others—

**Relief of Lourdes Latour and Edward Latour by Miami-Dade County;** Providing for the relief of Lourdes Latour and Edward Latour by Miami-Dade County; providing an appropriation to compensate Mr. and Mrs. Latour for injuries sustained as a result of the negligence of Miami-Dade County; providing a limitation on compensation and the payment of attorney fees, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Recommended favorably by the Special Master on Claim Bills; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### CS/SB 52 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Gaetz and others—

**Security Services at Places of Worship;** Providing an exemption from licensure requirements for certain volunteers who provide armed security services for places of worship, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice; the Committee on Judiciary reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

### CS/SB 62 (2R) by the Committee on Ethics and Elections, Senator Arrington and others—

**Candidate Qualification;** Specifying that a person seeking to qualify for office as a candidate must be a registered member of a political party, or registered without any party affiliation, for 365 consecutive days preceding the beginning of qualifying for an election; authorizing qualified candidates or certain political parties to challenge compliance with specified provisions by filing suit in a specified circuit court; prohibiting a person from being qualified as a candidate for nomination or election and appearing on the ballot under specified circumstances, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Ethics and Elections; the Committee on Judiciary reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

### SB 308 (2R) by Senator Leek and others—

**Florida Museum of Black History;** Establishing the Florida Museum of Black History Board of Directors; providing for the membership of the board; prohibiting specified members of the board from holding state or local elective office while serving on the board; requiring that the board work jointly with the Foundation for the Museum of Black History, Inc., etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### CS/SB 504 (2R) by the Appropriations Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice and Senator Burgess—

**Code Inspector Body Cameras;** Requiring a governmental entity that permits its code inspectors to wear body cameras to establish certain policies and procedures; requiring such governmental entity to ensure that certain training occurs, to retain certain data in accordance with public records laws, and to perform a periodic review of actual body camera practices; providing that certain provisions relating to the interception of wire, electronic, and oral communications do not apply to body camera recordings made by code inspectors, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Appropriations Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

### SB 506 (2R) by Senator Burgess—

**Public Records/Body Camera Recordings Recorded by a Code Inspector;** Providing an exemption from public records requirements for body camera recordings recorded by a code inspector under certain circumstances; providing exceptions; requiring a local government to retain body camera recordings for a specified timeframe; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: On the same date that SB 504 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; reported favorably by the Appropriations Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**CS/SB 564 (2R) by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 and Senator Yarborough—**

**Student Volunteers at Polling Locations;** Providing that specified high school students who volunteer to assist poll workers are not subject to provisions prohibiting certain agencies and state and local officials from soliciting, accepting, or otherwise using private funds or certain personal services for election-related expenses, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Ethics and Elections; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/SB 572 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Senator Harrell—**

**Ethics for Public Officers and Employees;** Revising the definition of the term "relative" to include foster parents and foster children, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Ethics and Elections; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/SB 590 (2R) by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs and Senator Bradley—**

**Statute of Limitations Period for Violations Involving Required Reports Concerning Children;** Providing that the period of limitation for offenses related to specified required reports concerning children does not begin to run until a law enforcement agency is made aware of the violation, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal Justice; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**SB 594 (2R) by Senator Burton and others—**

**Local Housing Assistance Plans;** Authorizing counties and eligible municipalities to expend certain funds on lot rental assistance for mobile home owners for a specified time period; requiring each county and eligible municipality to include in its local housing assistance plan certain strategies; authorizing counties and eligible municipalities to provide certain funds to mobile home owners for rehabilitation and emergency repairs, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; reported favorably by the Appropriations Committee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 624 (2R) by Senator Yarborough and others—**

**Batterers' Intervention Program Activities;** Authorizing batterers' intervention programs to offer supplemental faith-based activities, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**CS/SB 806 (2R) by the Committee on Agriculture and Senator Truenow—**

**Consumers' Right to Repair Certain Equipment;** Creating the "Portable Wireless Device Repair Act"; requiring portable wireless device manufacturers to make certain items available to device owners and independent repair providers; prohibiting certain manufacturers from requiring authorized repair providers to continue purchasing certain information in a proprietary format; requiring original equipment manufacturers of agricultural equipment to make certain diagnostic and repair information available for no charge and in a certain manner to independent repair providers and owners, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Commerce and Tourism; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Agriculture; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**SM 1186 (2R) by Senator Wright—**

**Florida National Guard Increased Force Structure;** Urging the Congress of the United States to impel the National Guard Bureau to examine the present allocations of the Florida National Guard and allow an increase in its force structure, etc.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 7020 (2R) by the Committee on Agriculture (Truenow)—**

**OGSR/Aquaculture Records Held by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services;** Amending a provision which provides an exemption from public record requirements for certain aquaculture records held by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 7024 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Mayfield)—**

**OGSR/Cybersecurity, Information Technology, and Operational Technology Information;** Providing an exemption from public records requirements for the cybersecurity, information technology, and operational technology information held by an agency; providing an exemption from public meetings requirements for any portion of a meeting that would reveal such information; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemptions; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 7026 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Mayfield)—**

**OGSR/Trade Secret Held by an Agency;** Amending a provision which provides an exemption from public records requirements for a trade secret held by an agency, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**HB 167 (2R) by Representatives McClure and Gentry—**

**Former Phosphate Mining Lands;** Provides conditions for cause of action against certain former phosphate mine sites; authorizes landowners to record certain notice of former phosphate mines; specifies requirements for such notice; requires DOH to conduct gamma radiation surveys of former phosphate land parcels upon petition; requires that specified documentation of radiation levels be submitted in certain civil actions related to phosphate mining. Effective Date: 07/01/2026

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**FIRST PUBLICATION ON SECOND READING**

**CS/SB 1396 (2R1) by the Committee on Rules and Senator Burton—**

**Litigation Financing Consumer Protection;** Citing this act as the "Litigation Investment Safeguards and Transparency Act"; authorizing courts to consider the existence of a litigation financing agreement under certain circumstances; prohibiting specified acts by litigation financiers; requiring certain parties to a legal proceeding, or their counsels of record, which have entered into a litigation financing agreement with a foreign person, a foreign principal, or a sovereign wealth fund to file and serve a notice identifying specified information with the court, agency, or tribunal and all other parties to the legal proceeding within a specified timeframe, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2026
