33	34	<b>RENEGOTIATIONS OF PRIVATE LEASE AGREEMENTS.</b> requires the Department of Management Services (DMS) and agencies to utilize a tenant broker to renegotiate private lease agreements, in excess of 2,000 square feet, expiring between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2024. Report required by November 1, 2021.	Similar
34	35	<b>DATA CENTERS/TRANSFERS FROM DATA PROCESSING CATEGORY.</b> Notwithstands s. 216.292(2)(a), F.S. which authorizes transfers of up to 5 percent of approved budget between categories. Prohibits an agency from transferring funds from a data processing category to any category other than another data processing category.	
35	36	<b>DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICE STATE DATA CENTER APPROPRIATION CATEGORY.</b> authorizes the Executive Office of the Governor (EOG) to transfer funds in the specific appropriation category “Data Processing Assessment – Department of Management Service” between agencies, in order to align the budget authority granted with the assessments that must be paid by each agency to the DMS.	
36	37	<b>RISK MANAGEMENT TRANSFERS.</b> authorizes the EOG to transfer funds in the appropriation category “Special Categories-Risk Management Insurance” between departments in order to align the budget authority granted with the premiums paid by each department for risk management insurance.	Similar
37	38	<b>HUMAN RESOURCE SERVICES TRANSFER.</b> authorizes the EOG to transfer funds in the appropriation category “Special Categories - Transfer to DMS - Human Resources Services Purchased per Statewide Contract” of the GAA for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 between departments, in order to align the budget authority granted with the assessments that must be paid by each agency to the DMS for human resources management services.	
38	39	<b>REPLACEMENT OF FLAIR.</b> defines the components of the Florida Accounting Information Resource subsystem (FLAIR) and Cash Management System (CMS) included in the Department of Financial Services' Planning, Accounting, and Ledger Management, (PALM) system. This section also provides the executive steering committee membership and the procedures for executive steering committee meetings and decisions.
