2	HCB	Managed Care Kick Payment for Gene Therapy (BOB)	Section XX. The nonrecurring sums of \$8,526,000 from the General Revenue Fund and \$11,474,000 from the Medical Care Trust Fund are provided to the Agency for Health Care Administration in Specific Appropriation 215 of Chapter 2024-231, Laws of Florida, for the purchase of prescription drugs used in cell and gene therapies for children who are Medicaid recipients with Metachromatic Leukodystrophy, Hemophilia, Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy, Sickle Cell Disease, and Spinal Muscular Atrophy. No recalculation of managed care capitation payments will be made based upon these direct purchases by the Agency for Health Care Administration. The unexpended balance of these funds on June 30, 2025 shall revert and is appropriated to the Agency for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 for the same purpose.
