CS for SJR 2-C-A joint resolution of apportionment; providing definitions; apportioning the senatorial districts of the state in accordance with the United States Decennial Census of 2010 (plan S040S9124); providing for the inclusion of omitted areas; providing contiguity for areas specified for inclusion in one senatorial district which are noncontiguous; specifying that the apportioned districts constitute the senatorial districts of the state; providing for severability of invalid portions; providing for application beginning in 2016.
