CLAIM BILLS

During the 2007 session, 35 claim bills were filed in the Senate. There were 30 companion bills filed in the House of Representatives. Also, there were three House claim bills filed that did not have a Senate companion.

Of the 35 bills filed in the Senate, 12 were approved by the House and Senate and one of the House companion bills was approved by the House and Senate. At this time, none of the claim bills have been approved by the Governor. If they all become law, they will authorize or direct payment of \$10,367,882 to be paid from local government budget accounts and \$13,300,000 to be paid from the General Revenue Fund.
