

HB 7193 — Public Records/Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program

by Governmental Affairs Policy Committee and Rep. Braynon (CS/CS/SB 2144 by Governmental Oversight and Accountability Committee and Education Pre-K – 12 Committee)

This bill reenacts the public records exemption for records of a child enrolled in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program that are held by an early learning coalition, the Agency for Workforce Innovation, or a Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program provider. These records are confidential and exempt from the public-records requirements and include assessment data, health data, records of teacher observations, and personal identifying information of the enrolled child and his or her parent.

If approved by the Governor, these provisions take effect October 1, 2010.
