## SB 1150 — Registration/Farm Labor Contractors and Employees

The bill provides that the Department of Business and Professional Regulation can renew a farm labor contractor's certificate of registration after the applicant's federal certificate of registration has expired if the applicant has timely filed for a renewal of the federal certificate. A renewal is timely filed if it has been filed with the U.S. Department of Labor at least 30 days before it expires. The bill also provides that the Department of Business and Professional Regulation shall suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew a certificate of registration if the federal certificate is suspended, revoked, or is not issued or renewed.

If approved by the Governor, these provisions take effect July 1, 2010.
