Senate Offer New Implementing Language

SECTION XXX. Notwithstanding section 216.311, Florida Statutes, or any other statute or rule that may otherwise be applicable, Purchase Order Number 7200 A4F71E and the corresponding agreement providing for the provision of certain tenant broker consulting services and preparation of a Leon County Master Real Estate Plan pursuant to contract number DMS 06/07-115, shall be valid and compensable.

SECTION XXX. In order to implement appropriations used for the payments of existing lease contracts for private lease space in excess of 2,000 square feet, the Department of Management Services, together with the cooperation of the agencies having the existing lease contracts, shall utilize tenant broker services to renegotiate or reprocure all private lease agreements expiring between July 1, 2013, and June 30, 2015, in order to achieve a reduction in costs in future years. The department shall incorporate this initiative into its 2012 Master Leasing Report and may use tenant broker services to explore the possibilities of collocation, to review the space needs of each agency, and to review the length and terms of potential renewals or renegotiations. The department shall provide a report by March 1, 2013, to the Executive Office of the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives which lists each lease contract for private office or storage space, the status of renegotiations, and the savings achieved. This section expires July 1, 2013.
