Executive Order of Suspension, Executive Order No. 19-14 Request for Consideration of Scot Peterson Arrest and Prosecution

Dear Special Master Goodlette:

Last week, as we were preparing for the depositions in this matter, we learned through media sources that former BSO Deputy Scot Peterson was arrested and charged with child neglect, perjury, and culpable negligence in connection with his actions during the Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School shooting incident. At the same time, we learned that FDLE conducted over 180 witness interviews, reviewed hours of surveillance video, and wrote over 200 investigative reports. Pursuant to the Florida Public Records law, the information currently in the possession of the FDLE and the Broward County State Attorney's Office are not only relevant but are likely exculpatory to Sheriff Israel.

Despite making inquiries and requests, it does not appear we will be accessible in the time frame involving these proceedings. Therefore, in the interest of Due Process, we request that this development be considered at the Pre-Hearing Conference on June 10, 2019, and its impact on these proceedings.
