Edna Giles Fuller, was the first woman elected to the Florida Legislature. She was born in Lake City, FL but moved to Orlando, and began her career as a public school teacher in Orange County. She was president of the Florida State Woman Suffrage Organization between 1919 and 1921. She was appointed to the position of Assistant Food Administrator for the State of Florida prior to running for office. Her legacy continues to inspire the women who are committed to public service in Florida.
